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Jan Kopecký celebrates 120 years of ŠKODA in motorsport with ninth victory at Bohemia Rally

- > On ŠKODA Motorsport's home soil, factory-supported Jan Kopecký, this time together with co-driver Jan Hloušek (ŠKODA FABIA Rally2 evo), won Bohemia Rally for a record ninth time
- > At the fourth round of the SONAX Czech Rally Championship, ŠKODA Motorsport entered Dominik Stříteský/Jiří Hovorka conquered an impressive second place with their ŠKODA FABIA Rally2 evo
- > With Jan Černý/Petr Černohorský finishing third, the Czech brand celebrated a pure ŠKODA podium
- World Rally Championship regulars Marco Bulacia Wilkinson/Marcel Der Ohannesian finished fifth behind their ŠKODA stablemates Filip Mareš/Radovan Bucha

Mladá Boleslav (CZE), 11 July 2021 – It was a celebration in style: By winning Bohemia Rally, ŠKODA Motorsport test driver Jan Kopecký gave the brand his personal gift on the occasion of the 120th anniversary of ŠKODA's activities in motorsport. The seven times Czech Rally Champion won together with co-driver Jan Hloušek ahead of shooting stars Dominik Stříteský/Jiří Hovorka, who were competing in a ŠKODA FABIA Rally2 evo carrying the ŠKODA Motorsport colours as well. It was Jan Kopecký's ninth victory at the Bohemia Rally, which took place around ŠKODA's hometown Mladá Boleslav.

The only competitor who could have spoiled the ŠKODA Motorsport party at Bohemia Rally, fourth round of the SONAX Czech Rally Championship 2021, was Ford driver Vacláv Pech. Right from the start, he was locked in a fierce battle with ŠKODA Motorsport's test driver Jan Kopecký. But on the sixth special stage, the hydraulic system of Pech's Ford failed. Kopecký took the lead, which was never in danger until the finish. "It is a very special moment for me, that I could achieve my ninth victory here. There is no better way to celebrate the 120th anniversary of ŠKODA's activities in motorsport," emphasized Jan Kopecký at the finish.

As a reward for good performances during the first three championship events, Dominik Stříteský drove Bohemia Rally with support from ŠKODA Motorsport. And the 21 years young talent delivered. Together with co-driver Jiří Hovorka he finished second with the ŠKODA FABIA Rally2 evo carrying the colours of the factory team. Jan Černý/Petr Černohorský of Louda Auto ŠKODA Racing Team in third place overall completed an all ŠKODA podium. Filip Mareš and co-driver Radovan Bucha, sharing an all-new limited production ŠKODA FABIA Rally2 evo Edition 120 from Laureta Auto ŠKODA Team, were initially holding second place. After a puncture during the eleventh stage they eventually finished fourth overall.

The third ŠKODA FABIA Rally2 evo in ŠKODA Motorsport colours was driven by 20 years old Marco Bulacia Wilkinson of Bolivia with Marcel Der Ohannesian of Argentina in the navigator's seat. The South American crew is currently third in the WRC2 overall standings of the FIA World Rally Championship and used the Bohemia Rally to improve its driving skills on tarmac. After setting third fastest time at the opening stage, they went off on the third stage, damaged the rear right wheel and could only continue after a roadside repair carried out by the crew. With brakes only on three wheels, they dropped to 12th position. After the ŠKODA FABIA Rally2 evo was properly repaired at service, Bulacia started a race to catch up. A string of fast stage times made him climb to fifth position at the finish.

"I have to thank Jan for his beautiful birthday present he gave to all of us to celebrate the 120th anniversary of ŠKODA's activities in motorsport. Again, he showed his speed and experience to win for the ninth time our home event. I am as well delighted by the strong performance of our young guns Dominik Stříteský and Marco Bulacia," said Michal Hrabánek, Director of ŠKODA Motorsport.

ŠKODA Motorsport Overview

ŠKODA has been successful in motorsports since 1901. Be it on the circuit or in rallies, ŠKODA has celebrated victories and won titles all around the world. Historical highlights include victory in the European Touring Car Championship 1981 as well as multiple titles in the FIA World Rally Championship's WRC2 category. Over the years, ŠKODA customer teams also won numerous national championships as well as titles in the FIA European Rally Championship (ERC), the der Intercontinental Rally Challenge (IRC), the FIA African Rally Championship (ARC), the FIA North American and Central American Rally Championship (NACAM), the FIA South American Rally Championship (CODASUR) and the FIA Asia-Pacific Rally Championship (APRC). ŠKODA teams have also triumphed in the world's oldest and most famous rally, taking several class victories in the legendary Rallye Monte-Carlo, which was first held in 1911.

In 2009, the ŠKODA FABIA SUPER 2000 took the rally scene by storm. The following seasons, the all-wheel-drive rally car with a 2.0 litres normally aspirated engine won 50 national and international titles worldwide. It then wrote the most successful chapter in ŠKODA's motorsport history – until its successor surpassed it. The ŠKODA FABIA R5, a production-based rally car with four-wheel drive and 1.6 litres turbo engine, was homologated in its original form by the International Automobile Federation FIA on 1 April 2015. Further developed to ŠKODA FABIA R5 evo (homologated on 1 April 2019), the high-tech car successfully continues the long tradition of ŠKODA Motorsport. Due to changes in regulations, the car was re-named ŠKODA FABIA Rally2 evo in 2020.

The success story of the ŠKODA FABIA R5 took off in 2016, when Esapekka Lappi (FIN) won the WRC2 drivers' title of the FIA World Rally Championship. The following year, Pontus Tidemand (SWE) won the WRC2 drivers' category, while ŠKODA Motorsport took the WRC2 manufacturers' title. In 2018, ŠKODA factory driver Jan Kopecký was crowned WRC 2 drivers' champion. 2019 was the most successful year in the history of ŠKODA Motorsport. Kalle Rovanperä and Jonne Halttunen (FIN/FIN) won the WRC2 Pro drivers' and co-drivers' title as well as substantially supporting ŠKODA Motorsport to win the WRC2 Pro manufacturers' title. In 2020 ŠKODA customer team Toksport WRT became Team Champion of the WRC2 category.
