
## **Škoda Auto Group in 2022: Financial Results**

Škoda Auto achieves solid financial figures in 2022 amid a very challenging environment.

Škoda Auto delivered **731,300 cars** to customers in 2022 despite semiconductor shortages and supply chain disruptions. Škoda Auto Group sales revenue totals over **21 billion euros**.

The negative impacts related to the war in Ukraine and subsequent suspension of the business in Russia estimated **at almost 700 million euros**.
