Škoda Auto enters Vietnamese market

In September, Škoda Auto began selling the Karoq and Kodiaq in Vietnam, targeting annual sales of over 40,000 units post-2030. The company sees Vietnam as a key gateway to the ASEAN region.



3 million Škoda SUVs produced

In September, Škoda celebrated producing its 3 millionth SUV. Since launching the Yeti in 2009, SUVs, including the Kodiaq, Karoq, Kamiq, and the all-electric Enyaq, have become an integral part of Škoda's lineup. Today, SUVs account for nearly half of the Czech automaker's global deliveries.

Škoda Auto comprehensively updated its compact Škoda Scala and Škoda Kamiq city SUV model series. Both models offer a very high level of active and passive safety, courtesy of rigid bodies and a now even more advanced range of assistance systems.

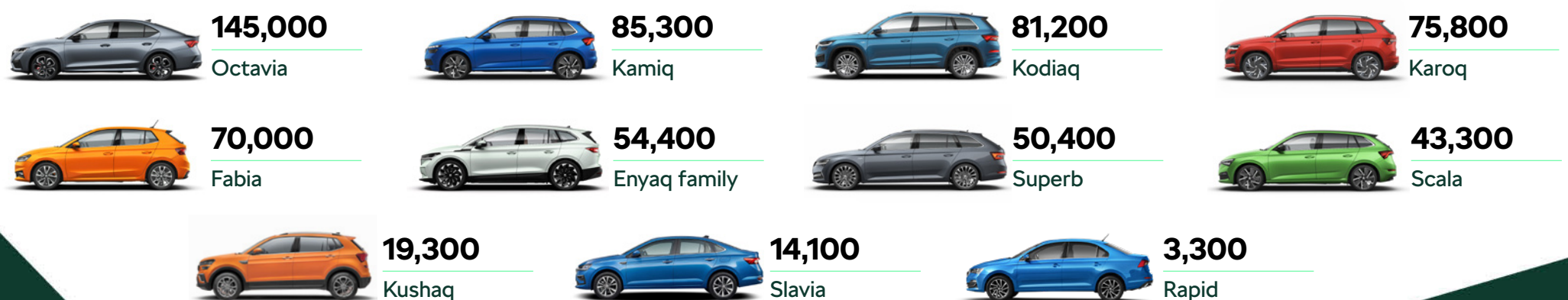
